Subject: Aluminum Extrusions - Recycled Content

EasyTrim Reveals environmental policy is to balance the needs of business with the long term needs of the environment. Although our recycled material percentages constantly change based upon the type of billet we used, currently approximately 25% of our product comes from recycled post-industrial aluminum.

While post-consumer aluminum is 100% recyclable, the extrusion process does not use a higher recycled content because of quality problems. A major concern is discoloration that occurs in the anodized finishing process. Other difficulties can occur in meeting the strength and hardness certifications we require.

In addition, all extruded profiles are manufactured in Portland, OR. Chemistry of the 6063 alloy is 98.6% aluminum and is within the chemical specifications as established by the Aluminum Association. 85% of the billet is produced within 500 miles of Portland, specifically Ferndale, WA.
